Articles of Confederation

- Provided for a **weak** national government
- Gave Congress no power to **tax** or regulate **commerce** among the states
- Provided for no common **currency**
- Gave each state **one** vote regardless of size
- Provided for no **executive** or **judicial** branch

Essential Understanding: The Articles of Confederation was a constitution written during the American Revolution to establish powers of the new national government.
