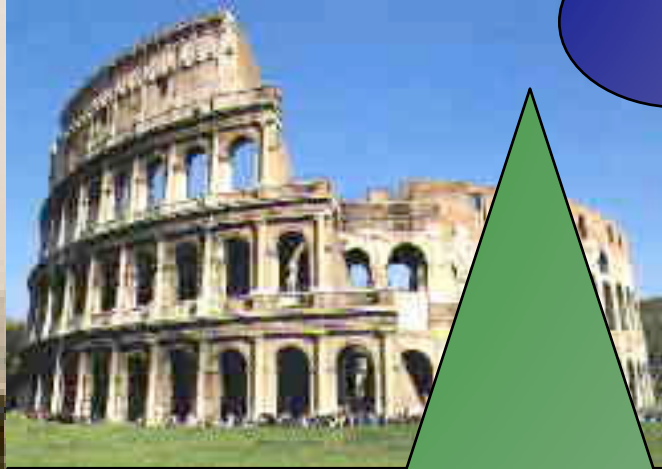


The United States constitutional system incorporates democratic elements that were developed in Athens and Rome.

Athens, Greece developed the concept of Direct democracy.
