- low wages - long hours
- Unsafe working conditions

Rise of organized labor:

- Formation of unions - American Federation of Labor
- Strikes - Homestead Strike

Progressive Movement workplace reforms:

- Improved safety conditions
- Reduced work hours
- Placed restrictions on child labor
