Take a day out of your summer to enrich your students' learning all year long!

Summer Teacher Workshops are designed to provide Virginia instructors with new insights into creating more engaging and stimulating lesson plans for their students. Each day-long session will focus on essential historical facts that the teacher can take back to the classroom. Emphasis will be placed on events of the past and their continued impact through time.

Professional development courses include:

Age of Exploration: June 28th and August 2nd

Slavery & the Transatlantic Slave Trade: June 29th and August 3rd

The Battle of Hampton Roads: June 30th and August 4th

Examine the role ironclads played in the Peninsula Campaign and the overall Civil War effort. History & Social Science SOLs: VS.1, VS.7, USI. 9, USII.3, VUS.1, VUS.7
